Early College Program

The Early College Program offers a unique opportunity to become a dual-enrolled student at TvF High School and the CUNY Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC). Students enrolled in the college courses earn credits towards the Video, Arts, and Technology Degree program at BMCC, which students can earn should they decide to continue the program into years 13 and 14. These college course credits also transfer and apply towards the general education requirements at any College or University the students attend in the future.

A distinctive feature of this program is that BMCC courses are entirely free for all TvF students. Regardless of citizenship, everyone is welcome to sign up for these courses, fostering an inclusive and accessible learning environment. The program provides the students with a head start in their higher education journey and enhancing their academic and professional readiness. **Enrollment in BMCC courses is determined by completion of an interest application and availability of seats. Freshmen are currently not permitted to take college courses.**
